The Speedmaster Gonzales™ Vintage Moonwatch Market Report

Week of September 20 – 26, 2026 · Published September 26, 2026

The week: A quiet week with two verified prints: a 145.012-67 sold for \$4,800 on eBay (September 20, 25-bid auction, unpolished cal. 321) and a pre-moon 145.022-69 sold for \$3,799.99 (September 21, best offer accepted) - the only confirmed realized sales across all nine vintage references. Auctions, forums, and dealer archives yielded nothing verifiable in-window, and dealer asking prices stayed firm.

Methodology

Research covered eBay sold/completed listings, Chrono24, published results from Phillips, Christie's, Sotheby's, Antiquorum, and Bonhams (plus regional houses: Wilson55, Sworders, Dawsons, Fellows, Dorotheum, Kaplans, Bamfords, Blenheim, FauveParis), timed-online platforms (Watch Collecting, Grailzee, Bezel, Loupe This, Catawiki), aggregation pages (EveryWatch), and viewable enthusiast marketplaces (Omega Forums, WatchUSeek, WatchRecon, Analog:Shift, HQ Milton, Watch Club London, Bulang and Sons) for the week of September 20-26, 2026. Realized prices are sales confirmed as completed with a published price and an in-window date; asking prices are current dealer listings, labeled as such and never mixed with realized figures. Prices are reported as listed; no currency conversion was applied. Coverage notes: both eBay sales below were live-verified on 2026-09-22 and carry verified ledger records; direct eBay access was unreachable on 2026-09-26, so eBay sales closing September 23-26 may be under-covered (web-search supplements found no additional dated candidates, but this is a blind spot, not a confirmed zero); Chrono24 publishes no sold data, so it counts as asking-price-only coverage; dealer sold archives rarely publish sold dates or prices; no flagship vintage-watch auction with published in-window results for the nine references fell this week. Glass Case inputs: the nightly listing watch logged a Catawiki 145.022 no-reserve lot (1991) at a EUR 3,100 current bid (10 bids, closes September 27) and 30 new tracked IDs; the off-board layer recorded a Chrono24 Ed White 105.003 tropical dial (was \$11,995 asking, off 2026-09-23), a Grailzee CK 2998-4 (was \$12,000 Buy Now, off 2026-09-22), and a Grailzee 1968 ST 145.012 (off 2026-09-25) - off the board is never a confirmed sale. Gaps are reported honestly - no sales were invented or estimated.

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
